

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT

Read all instructions before assembly. Installation is to be done by a qualified professional. For wet locations, junction between the mounting surface and luminaire must be sealed with caulking.


CAUTION: Risk of fire, this product must be installed in accordance with the applicable installation code by a person familiar with the construction and operation of the product and the hazards involved.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Disconnect power at the electrical panel before installation.
- 2. Thread nut (A) and top loop (B) onto the nipple (C). Screw top loop (B) on all the way.
- 3. Thread nipple (C) into crossbar (D). Don't tighten anything into place yet.
- 4. Place socket gasket (E) onto socket (F). Feed socket cord through shade (G), coupler o-ring (H) and coupler (I).
- 5. Insert socket (F) into the shade (G) and screw on coupler (I) (rotate coupler counter-clockwise). NOTE: Ensure coupler o-ring (H) is seated in coupler (I) groove.
- 6. Feed cord through chain (J) and thread chain bottom loop (K) into the coupler (I).
- 7. Feed cord through adjustment ring (L), canopy (M), top loop (B) and nipple (C).
- 8. Crimp metal strain relief clamp (N) to cord above crossbar (D) with pliers.
- 9. Mount crossbar (D) to junction box (O) with two mounting screws (P). NOTE: Mounting screws (P) not included.
- 10. Use wire nuts (Q) to connect power supply to the black wire and neutral wire to the white wire. NOTE: Wire nuts (Q) not included.
- 11. Use wire nut (Q) to attach ground wire (R) to the junction box (O), green wire or bare wire and also to the crossbar (D). NOTE: Wire nuts (Q) not included.
- 12. Temporarily place canopy (M) flush with the ceiling and adjust the length of the nipple (C) until the top loop's (B) threads protrude roughly 1/4" through canopy (M). After nipple (C) length is adjusted, tighten nut (A) to lock into
- 13. Fit canopy (M) over top loop (B) and tighten adjustment ring (L) until canopy (M) is secure and flush against the ceiling.
- 14. Connect guick-link (S) to top loop (B) to finish installation.

ALTERNATE FIXTURES

Although the illustration below includes an RLM shade, these alternative fixtures follow the same installation instructions.






Blue Collar Fixture


Guard & Glass Fixture
