

Job Title: Wet Spray Painter

Department: Paint & Porcelain

Reports to: Manufacturing Supervisor

Job Summary: Responsible for managing parts and orders for all orders that get sprayed white inside. Spraying requires sanding the inside of the shade after it has been powder coated to create a nice quality finish. Responsible for ensuring the parts are clean and free of debris.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Maintain spray equipment, guns, gun cleaner, spray booth
- Spray and wipe shades and store on shelves to dry while keeping work orders with the parts to ensure they are delivered to QC together
- Once parts are painted and dried, they are placed on pallets the following morning and delivered to QC. Clean out all orders from the spray room from the previous day
- Responsible for keeping an eye on materials and supplies to perform the job of painting a large volume of shades on a daily basis
- Keep work area clean
- Wear PPE necessary for the job
- Sand and tack rag shades then move into area to be sprayed
- Spray shades with HVLP gun and wipe overspray from shade
- Maintain records of coated parts, keep work orders with parts
- Adheres to all company policies, procedures, and business ethics codes
- Maintain regular and prompt attendance
- Perform other duties as assigned

Required Skills

- 2 years' experience in painting area is preferred but not mandatory
- Work in a fast-paced environment
- Self-starter with good attitude and works well as a team member
